

CINDERELLA(ROCKAFELA)

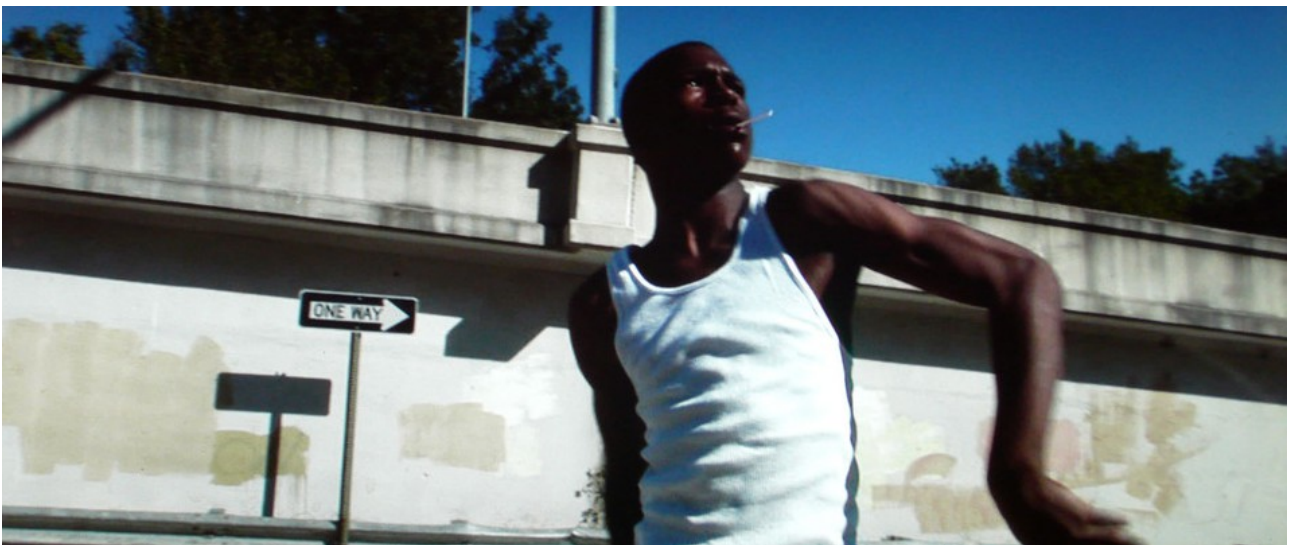
On Wednesday 24th June 2015 the DANCE FILMMAKER **Alex Reuben** will be coming to Trinity Laban. Alex will give a talk and show some of his short films and also ask for your participation for his current project Cinderella (RockaFela) a movie about neuroscience, dance and improvisation, supported by the Wellcome trust and Arts Council England.

Alex Reuben makes movies for cinema characterised by improvisation, sound and movement – a process he calls 'choreogeography'. Reuben's films look at the connections between politics, environment and the way that we move. They are exhibited in the UK by the BFI, Picturehouse, Curzon and Home Cinemas. His movie *Routes-Dancing to New Orleans*, a dance road-movie during Hurricane Katrina, was selected in the 'Top 20 Movies of the Decade' by film critic Geoff Andrew.
